Instructables is one of my favorite sites because you can learn how to make just about anything here. And they've got a <u>great recipe</u> for homemade shampoo. This recipe uses liquid Castile soap.

You need:

1/4 cup water

1/4 cup liquid Castile soap (like Dr. Bronner's, which you can find cheaply on Amazon; you can also get awesome, organic Castile soap from <u>Mountain Rose Herbs</u>)
1/2 teaspoon oil (like jojoba, olive oil, or grapeseed)

Mix all the ingredients into a plastic or glass bottle and you're good to go!

As far as the results, it's a mixed bag with this recipe. Some people love this combination; others says it leaves a film on their hair. Again, a lot will depend on your hair type and your water type (hard water seems to leave more film).
