UDIG will again be offering weekly boxes of fruit and vegetables this summer for 10 weeks, July 22 through September 16. Boxes will contain 5 or 6 items each, and depending on the season, will include berries, lettuces, other greens, and late summer crops such as tomatoes, green beans, or corn.

A subscription for all 10 boxes will be \$150, as it has been the past two seasons.

Eggs from Sayda will again be an option; one dozen each week for \$35.

We expect Billy, Fred, Alpha, Rose, Tchanan, and Marina to again be the gardeners supplying items.

Boxes typically contain a newsletter with news about our gardens and recipe ideas.

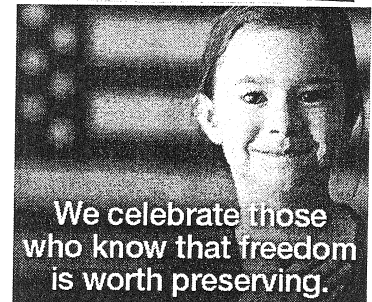
