Our fire service is better prepared now than we have been in many years. Community involvement and donations are up slightly which has allowed us to make much needed repairs to some of our equipment. Meeting attendance is up and there are more people able to set up and operate our equipment. We are about to switch to a far better 911 notification system offered by the county and available to us through the generosity of the Florence Police who operate the West Lane County Public Service Answering Point. The possibility of becoming a recognized fire department is on the horizon with the beginning of discussions with the Swisshome Fire District about annexing. All of these improvements are great, but even the most prepared rural fire departments are going to be challenged to arrive at a fire quickly.

If you have a fire on your property there is a very good chance that you will be the first one on the scene. Will you be proactive about fighting that fire while the fire service mobilizes to respond or will you watch it double in size every minute while you wait for help? A 10lb ABC fire extinguisher in every building (a must have item) can be enough to save the day if a fire is caught early enough, but once that extinguisher is empty you will be playing the waiting game again. High pressure portable fire pumps will not run out of water and will allow you to maintain an initial attack until more help arrives. These pumps are more expensive than most homeowners will want to spend on their own (\$3,000 and up for pump, hose etc.) but if purchased collectively by groups of neighbors they are more affordable. If a few groups of neighbors in different parts of the valley were to purchase their own pumps, the ability to get water on a fire quickly, anywhere in the valley, would be greatly improved. The Deadwood Creek Fire Service would like to help groups of neighbors choose the appropriate equipment for your situation and work with you to learn how to use it. 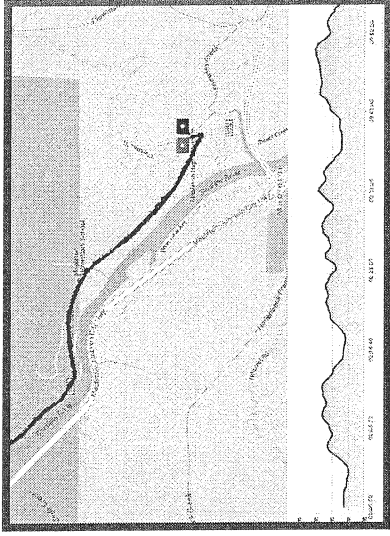
Shiloh was ahead of his time in the field of collaborative conservation. He was a PhD candidate in Geography at Oregon State University, cattle manager at Rock Creek Ranch in Deadwood, a Program Director at the Siuslaw Institute, and a vocal advocate for conservation solutions in the Siuslaw watershed and abroad. He believed we could have both protection and productivity on the same landscape and worked to bring that about with community-based leadership across the US West and in Kenya.

While working for SWC ten years ago, Shiloh created *The Siuslaw Salmon Run* as a fun and fundraising event. With the encouragement of Shiloh's family, SWC is happy to revive it in his honor as *The Salmon Run/Walk and Celebration!*

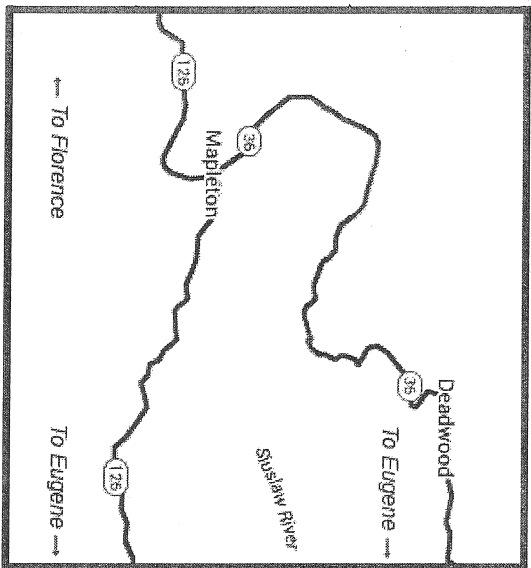
