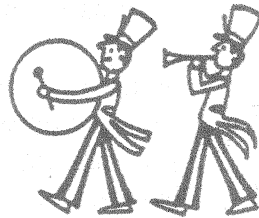

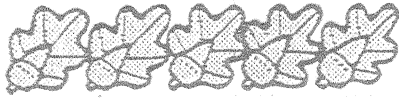

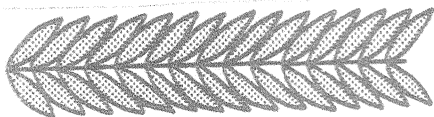

Vegan Seed Cheese

Cottage cheese consistency

Some people have enjoyed this on Pizza lately so here is the recipe to make your own. Great as a dip too. Experiment with your own combinations, herbs and spices.

Basic Sunflower Seed Cheese

1 cup Sunflower seeds preferably soaked in water 2-3 hours and then drained.
2 tbs Nutritional yeast flakes
pinch of salt
½ tsp tumeric
½ tsp cumin
pinch of chilli and black pepper.
A splash of olive oil.

Place all in blender, grind together at a low speed. Add water slowly for desired creamy consistency. Eat as a dip or a spread, or spoon onto Pizza, Lasagna, or other dishes and bake
for your dairy free option

Variations.

½ sunflower seeds
¼ raw cashews or pumpkin seeds
¼ hemp seeps
replace cumin with 1 tbs dill.
1 tsp garlic granules

Leave in a covered glass vessel in the sun or warm place to ferment for 2-3 hours to ferment and blend flavors.
Sunflower seeds are very health giving, rich in vitamin E, a powerful antioxidant.

Thank you to everyone who made this project possible:



Mapleton School District received two Seismic Rehabilitation Grants totaling \$2.9 million!

Mapleton Elementary School has received a \$1.4 million Seismic Grant and Mapleton High School has received a \$1.5 million Seismic Grant. These funds will be used, in addition to the bond funds, to upgrade our facilities to ensure they are seismically safe for our students. This will also allow them to be a community gathering place in case of a natural disaster.

Construction on the Elementary school is scheduled to begin on June 16, 2017 and be completed on November 1, 2017. We have enough structural information on the Elementary School that we are able to remain on schedule while incorporating the seismic improvements allowed through the grant. Even though construction will be continuing during the school year, it will not impact our student's education.

Construction on the High School WAS also scheduled to begin on June 1, 2017. However, due to the additional seismic grant award, the engineer needs to gather additional structural information in order to include the seismic improvements allowed through the grant in our construction projects. Therefore, construction at the High School will begin in mid-December 2017 and is scheduled to be completed in late August of 2018.

Please note that community use of the facilities during construction will not be allowed. This is for safety and security purposes. However, once construction is completed, our facilities will once again be open for community use!
